Environmental Policy

The management and staff of Lewinnick Lodge are committed to the preservation of our environment. Recognising the responsibility we have both locally and globally, we have developed a number of programmes to "Reduce, Re-use and Recycle" wherever possible.

In delivering our commitment we will:

- comply with relevant environmental legislation and take a proactive approach to future requirements and obligations;
- seek to conserve natural resources through the responsible use of energy, water and materials but also maintaining the quality of service expected by our guests.

Examples of everyday actions:

- collect recyclable items separately (cardboard, plastic, glass, metals, food waste, etc.);
- engage in achieving a reduction in the energy consumption of our hotel by:
 - having effective energy efficient lighting installed;
 - having a guest towel reuse/bed linen changing programme in place to save water;
 - the use of solar panels;
 - the use of bio mass boilers instead of natural gas;
 - using our own water supply direct from an on-site borehole;
 - the purchase of local products where available thereby minimising the environmental impact of both production and distribution;
- actively promote recycling both internally and amongst our customers and suppliers.

Regularly monitor performance and aim for continued improvement and reduction of our carbon footprint and the environmental impact of our business.
